BUDGET ISSUES EXPLAINED

Contained below are some of the resolutions that Local 2250 has been able to negotiate with the school system which have lessened the adverse budget effects on Local 2250 members:

- Current union contract will be extended one (1) year 2010-2011
- Members whose work year was to be reduced from 11-months to 10-months will remain at 11-months
- Furlough days will be reduced by one (1) day for 12- and 10-month employees
- Work week during summer months will be eight (8) hours per day, four (4) days per week
- Over 300 positions have been saved which will result in significantly fewer layoffs.

While Local 2250 has been able to reduce the affects of this budget shortfall, we realize there are still matters which adversely affect our members. Please be assured that Local 2250 will continue to attempt to lessen the effects of these issues.
