## **CURRENT CONTRACT EXTENDED**

The current contract between Local 2250 and the Board of Education which would have ended on June 30, 2010, has been extended to June 30, 2011. The extension does not include a cost of living adjustment or a merit increase. An agreement was reached that the increment for 2009/2010 will be funded within the next three (3) years.

## **REDUCTION IN FORCE**

Current budget reductions have resulted in layoffs for members of Local 2250 as well as the other school employee unions. The union continues to work with the funding authorities to reduce the total number of employees being RIFed.

## **EMPLOYEE FURLOUGHS**

All current employees of the school system are currently scheduled to be furloughed. Twelve-month employees are scheduled to be furloughed 10-days and 10 and 11-month are scheduled to be furloughed five (5) days.

Twelve- and 11-month employees who are scheduled to have their reclassification changed to 10-month employment will not be furloughed. Once again, the Union continues to work with management to attempt to reduce the number of furlough days.
