REQUIRED TO WORK ON CODE YELLOW DAYS?

Local 2250 has received numerous calls relative to the correct compensation for those employees who are required to work on “**CODE YELLOW DAYS**” days when non emergency or nonessential employees are given the day off with pay.

The union contract provides language which requires the Board of Education to compensate employees who are required to work on Code Yellow days an additional 12 hours of compensatory time. The actual language contained in the union contract states as follows:

ART 7 – Personnel Policies, Sec 9 – Overtime

- H. When central offices have been closed due to a weather emergency the following will apply.
 - 2. When the hours worked during a weather emergency will not result in a work week in excess of forty (40) hours the compensation will be in the form of compensatory time off at the rate of time and one-half (1-1/2).

Should you have problems relative to this question, we suggest you quote the contract language to your supervisor. If this fails, call Local 2250 at 301-809-0472 and report your concern to the field staff representative.
